To amend chapter 303 of title 46, United States Code, to provide fair treatment for the families of those killed on the high seas.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Survivors Equality Act
- 5 of 2010".
- 6 SEC. 2. FAIR TREATMENT FOR THE FAMILIES OF THOSE
- 7 KILLED ON THE HIGH SEAS.
- 8 Chapter 303 of title 46, United States Code, is
- 9 amended by striking section 30303 and inserting the fol-
- 10 lowing:

1 "§ 30303. Amount and apportionment of recovery

- 2 "(a) Definition.—In this section, the term 'non-
- 3 pecuniary loss' means loss of care, comfort, and compan-
- 4 ionship.
- 5 "(b) Recovery.—The recovery in an action under
- 6 this chapter shall be a fair compensation for the pecuniary
- 7 and nonpecuniary loss sustained by the individuals for
- 8 whose benefit the action is brought. The individuals for
- 9 whose benefit the action is brought may also recover dam-
- 10 ages for the decedent's pre-death pain and suffering.".

11 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- The amendment made by this Act shall take effect
- 13 on the date of enactment of this Act and apply to any
- 14 civil action filed on or after that date.
